

# Lesson 18

**NT Book:** Revelation

**Book Theme:** Jesus Wins

**Key Verse:** Revelation 1:8

**Summary:** The Book of Revelation speaks of the second coming of Jesus, when he will be revealed in all his glory (Rev. 19:11-16)! All will be judged at that time. Those who do not believe in Jesus as the ultimate sacrifice for their sins will be judged by their works as recorded in the books (Rev. 20:11-15). But those whose names are written in the Book of Life will live forever with their Creator in the new heaven and new earth, where there will be no death, grief, crying or pain (21:3-4)! No matter what happens in this life, those who trust in Jesus can look forward to the day of His coming, knowing that in the end, Jesus Wins!

**Video:** Fly over of events mentioned in Revelation (Rev. 1:8; 19:11-16; 20:11-15; 21)

**Teaching Points::** The plan of salvation is presented one more time, with the end in mind.

Place each set in a bag with the appropriate label...NT Book, VERSE/THEME, ZONK!

**HOW TO PLAY** Divide the class into two teams. A representative from each team draws an item from each of the first two bags to determine if the team will be asked the Key Verse or Theme and from which book of the Bible. If the team answers successfully, the representative draws an item out of the point bag. He/she can keep drawing from the point bag (ideally as the team instructs) until they feel like they've risked it enough and would like to stop, or until they draw out a ZONK! If a ZONK! is drawn, all the points from that round are lost. The opportunity to draw is now passed to the other team.

Keep score on a white board or butcher paper so all can see. Remember to leave up the previous score until the turn is completely over, as the score could revert back to what it was at the beginning of the round. As the competition heats up, kids often find themselves chanting, "Points, Points, Points" or "Zonk! Zonk! Zonk!" and, if they aren't careful, they'll have a lot of fun!
