Romans

Theme: The Gospel Explained

Key Verse: For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 6:23

Romans

After Saul's conversion on the road to Damascus, God used him in incredible ways. Paul's missionary journeys took him all over the Roman empire, but despite Paul's intentions, not to Rome itself (1:13). Finally, on his third missionary journey, Paul settled for fully explaining the Gospel to the Romans in a letter he sent with a woman named Phoebe to "all the saints in Rome." Paul explained that ALL have sinned (3:23) and that, because of that sin, we ALL deserve death (6:23). BUT, while we were still sinners, Christ died for us and paid the penalty of our sin so that we can be declared righteous by His blood (5:8-9). The righteous live by FAITH in what Jesus did, not by trying to do right things ourselves (4:3-5). Finally, if we confess with our mouths Jesus is Lord and believe in our hearts that God raised him from the dead, we will be saved (10:9). No condemnation now exists for those who are in Christ Jesus (8:1). Now THAT is good news!

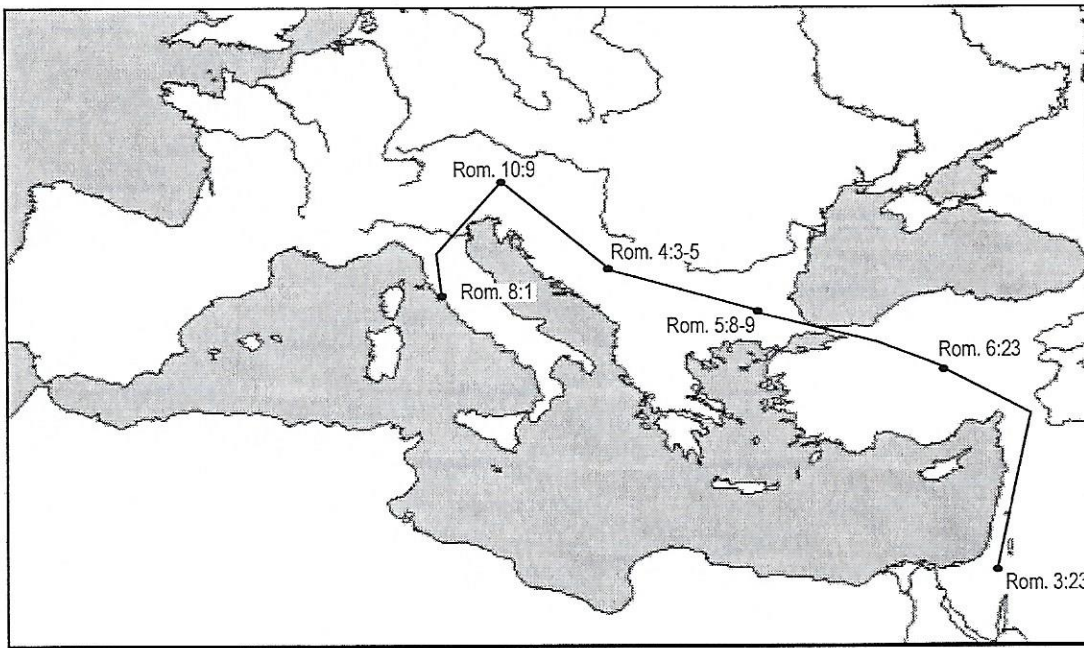
